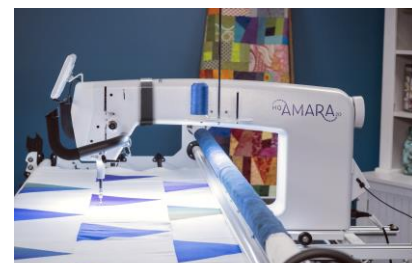
Whether you quilt on a longarm frame, “sit-down” machine or are interested in learning new possibilities, **Come join us for a three day event with national educator Amy Domke**
